<u>Summary paragraph</u>: Updates to the *Index Herbariorum* database during this period included the addition of 25 new herbaria and 80 new staff members. Collectively the world's herbaria reported the addition of 311,339 specimens during this period. One herbarium was reported as permanently closed, and 57 staff were reported as no longer associated with herbaria. Net gains are 24 herbaria and 23 staff for the quarter. As of 30 September 2025, there are 4029 herbaria with 13,691 staff in the registry, reporting a total of 403,988,134 specimens.
